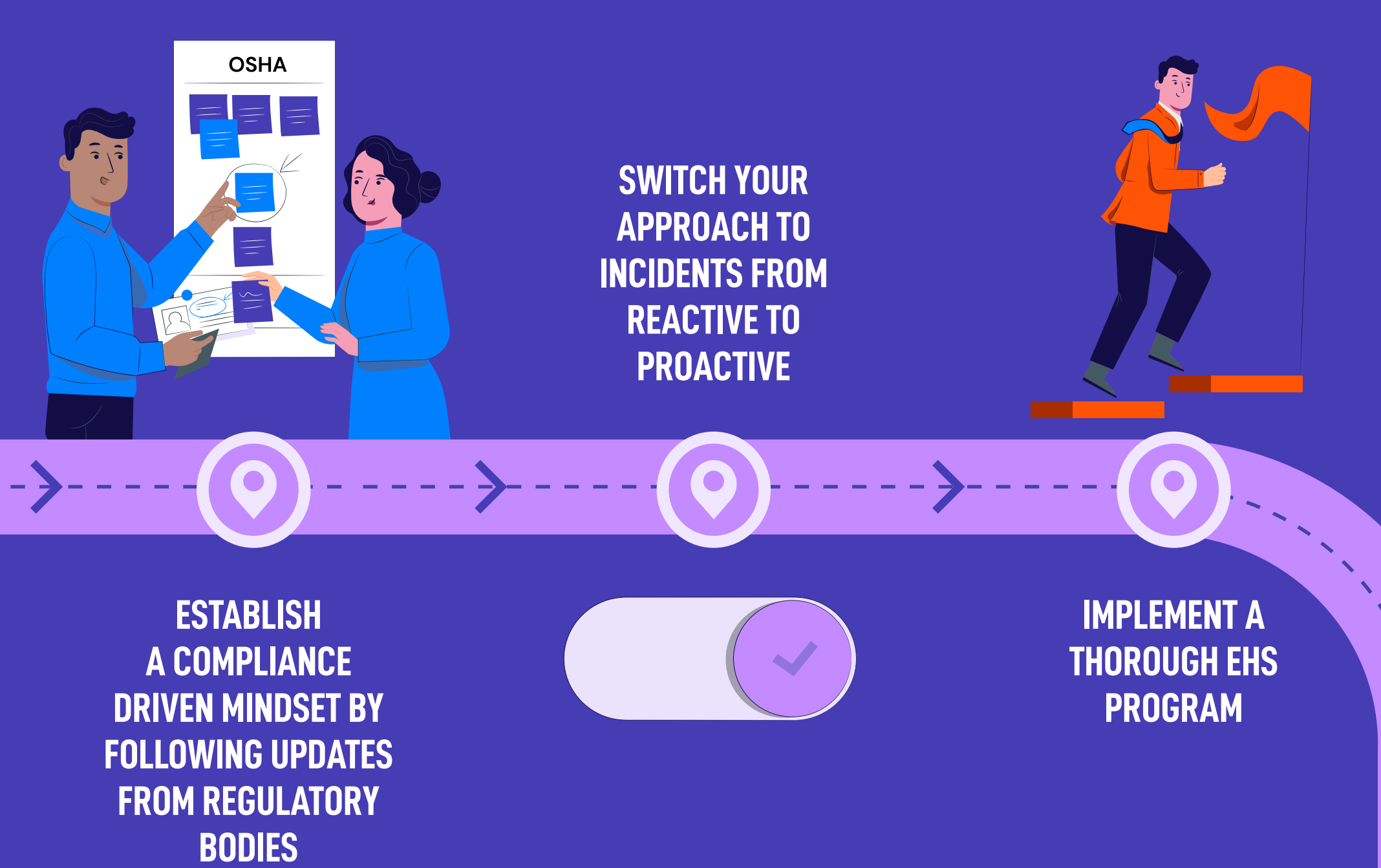
STAGE 01 NEGLIGENCE

Organization has no EHS accountability or a basic policy in place.



STAGE 02 REACTIVE

An organization has an EHS policy but typically reacts when an incident occurs rather than implementing preventative measures.



STAGE 04 PROACTIVE

Organization sees compliance as a baseline for EHS policy, but puts preventative measures in place.



STAGE 03 COMPLIANT

Organization has a clear understanding of regulations/areas that need EHS attention and a dedicated team to roll the program out.



STAGE 05 ACHIEVING EXCELLENCE

Organization understands that EHS is not an endgame, but a continuous journey.
