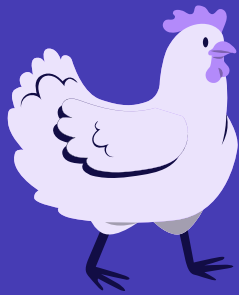


INCIDENT MANAGEMENT OR INCIDENT PREVENTION?
